### **BUILD UP HOURS**

Exhibitor Bump In- Monday May 31st 9:00am - 5:00pm

Please Note: During bump in and bump out phase, the only point of access for all Exhibitors and Contractors, is via Hall 1 Loading dock. This is accessed via the Service Road off Glenelg Street, South Brisbane. Please follow the Pedestrian walkway which is clearly marked in yellow and maroon stripes.

- Collect your Exhibitor Badge on arrival if you have not pre-printed badge.
- No children under the age of 16 permitted within the Exhibition Halls during the Bump In Period.
- All forklift activity ceases after 0900. Schenker Australia can provide freight movement via trolley or pallet jack.
- BCEC Brisbane and the Organiser are not able to accept delivery of any goods on behalf of clients or exhibitors. Please ensure that all deliveries are logged with Schenker Australia.
- Exhibition Hall closes strictly 1700.

# **IMPORTANT ACCESS REQUIREMENTS**

High visibility clothing or vest and steel toe footwear are required at all times during build-up and dismantle.

## **GENERAL EXHIBITION SECURITY**

Overall surveillance of the exhibition site is provided by the organizer. Equipment displayed on the booth is the responsibility of the exhibitor, day and night. You should take all appropriate measures to be protected against damage and theft. Exhibitors are advised to assign an appointed staff member to watch over their own booth. Be sure to take all necessary measures to ensure the safety of your belongings. If you require additional security in your booth, please log in to your online exhibitor manual and place an order for those services with the venue.

# WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF EMERGENCY?

**Should you have an emergency, dial 000**. In the case of an emergency of any type, notify event security or contact the BCEC Security Department. The Emergency (in-house) contact number is '8'. If dialing from a mobile phone or external phone, the number is 3308 3035.

On hearing the evacuation tone all persons should proceed immediately to the nearest emergency exit and proceed to the closest emergency assembly point. The BCEC assembly point is located on the grass area on the corner of Merivale and Glenelg streets.
